Driving directions

I suggest you print out the directions because some guests have found they didn't get a cell signal when they needed to check their gps (and gps sometimes gives less-than-ideal directions).

My directions may seem complicated but it really isn't. I just try to give lots of landmarks to help).

Coming from the east (Winchester, VA), take US Rt. 50 West through Capon Bridge, WV, and continue about 12 miles to WV Rt. 29 NORTH (do NOT turn left onto Rt. 29 South, which turns off next to a Liberty gas station/convenience market--continue on a couple more miles to Rt. 29 NORTH, which turns right towards Paw Paw and Slanesville.

From that turn go exactly 2 miles to Hoy Rd. on the right and turn right. (The turn is sharper than a 90-degree turn, so be sure to slow way down to take it safely.) Then go 1.7 miles out Hoy Rd. to the Just Far Enough Getaway sign/driveway on your right. You'll come up a steep hill and Hoy Rd. turns sharply to the left just before you reach that driveway, which is about 3 telephone poles' distance from the corner. You'll also see our green address sign -- 1806--on the mailbox post on the left opposite the driveway.

Turn into the driveway and again immediately to the right into the parking area in front of the log-sided house, which is Just Far Enough Getaway.

From north and west (Cumberland, MD). You'll come East on I68, exit to Industrial Blvd /Rt51, take to Canal Parkway which splits off to the right and crosses the river and merges into WV 28. follow all the way in to Romney. This route is quite twisty, so do drive cautiously. In Romney you'll come to Rt.50/Main St. at the traffic light by the courthouse. Turn left onto Rt.50 and go about 8 miles to Rt29 North. About a half mile before the turn you'll pass a BP gas station on the right. There is a left turn lane with well lighted overhead sign that says PawPaw. Turn left and go exactly 2 miles, where you turn right onto Hoy Rd. (WV Rt45/8 or 45/13 depending on your GPS). The latitude is 39.3138624 and the longitude is -78.5580665. It is sharper than a 90 degree turn, so be sure to slow down to make the turn. Go 1 and 7/10 miles to the driveway for Just Far Enough Getaway on your right. You'll know you near when you come up a steep hill and the road turns sharply left at the top. Look for the 1806 mailbox reflective sign on the left and the Just Far Enough sign on the right. Turn immediately again right into the parking area in front of the log-sided house close to the road and you're here!

From South and West (through Petersburg/Moorefield, WV) up WV Rt. 220 Take Rt. 220 to US Rt. 50, turn east and follow to Romney, where it becomes Main St. From the traffic light by the courthouse continue about 8 miles to Rt29 North. About a half mile before the turn you'll pass a BP gas station on the right. There is a left turn lane with well lighted overhead sign that says PawPaw. Turn left and go exactly 2 miles, where you turn right onto Hoy Rd. (WV Rt45/8 or 45/13 depending on your GPS). The latitude is 39.3138624 and the longitude is -78.5580665. It is sharper than a 90 degree turn, so be sure to slow down to make the turn. Go 1 and 7/10 miles to the driveway for Just Far Enough Getaway on your right. You'll know you near when you come up a steep hill and the road turns sharply left at the top. Look for the 1806 mailbox reflective sign on the left and the Just Far Enough sign on the right. If you come through Romney you may want to stop at the Food Lion just East of Romney up the hill in Hampshire Square Shopping Center (you'll see Burger King and FNB Bank at the entrance) for any perishables you may need.

Parking. Guests drive right up to the front porch for unloading and can park up to 3 cars in that area. If you have more vehicles, there is additional parking space available just a bit further up our driveway. There are two steps from the driveway into the house, with a hand rail.

WiFi. Just Far Enough Getaway accesses a wifi signal from our DSL router across the yard. You'll find the network name and password in the welcome memo at the house. Our service is rural and not particularly fast, so it may well be less robust than you are accustomed to, but you should be able to check email and surf the net.

Check-in instructions

Check in generally is **any time after 3PM**, unless we have a big party the preceding night, which might need a little longer for clean up. We'll alert you as soon as possible if that is the case, but almost always can be ready for you by 3PM. We live next door (across a wide lawn, so you have privacy, but we're handy). If we're going to be on premises we will greet you on arrival, but if not, will arrange for the door to be unlocked so you can get in. The keys will be on the kitchen counter along with a detailed memo about the house, covering where things are, how things work, the history of the house and such. If we are in town, we'll come by to meet you on our return. If we're out of town, there will be a neighbor's number in addition to my cell phone for assistance if needed. When you arrive, if for some reason there is no hot water, the circuit box is in the middle bedroom and probably just needs to have the switches flipped, and you'll have hot water in about 20 minutes. (We turn it off when no guests are staying to reduce energy use.)

Check-out instructions

Check out time is usually 11AM, but can be flexible, depending on whether other guests are scheduled for the night you depart. We can confer as your visit approaches to accommodate.

When you depart, please be sure to put the keys back on the kitchen counter and please **DO NOT** lock the deadbolt on the side door (we no longer have a key to it).

We love it if you sign the guest book and let us know about your stay.

We assume you'll leave the house approximately as you found it, other than laundry. If you care to, sheets can be pulled off the beds and put with towels in front of the laundry closet. You do not need to do the laundry.

Dishes should be washed and either left in the dishwasher or drainer in the sink. (If anything spills on the stove or in the oven, please wipe it up so it doesn't get baked on.) If any supplies are depleted or nearly used up, a note on the refrigerator notepad will be helpful so we know to restock.

A lined can is provided for recyclables (glass, metal, plastic, cardboard, newspapers)--please be sure to rinse out any food debris. Recyclables must be stored until we can transport them to Winchester to a recyclable center.

Please close the bag for trash/garbage, and it can be put outside in the metal can or left in the kitchen.

Please set thermostats back to 50 degrees when you depart to help reduce energy use.

Finally, to save yourself hassles when you get home, please make a careful run-through to check that you haven't left chargers in wall sockets or items that might have found their way under beds.
