1. Treasurer's Report:

- a. On Jun 10, 2017, at 3:13 PM, John Kirk <ibitinobi@hotmail.com> wrote, Here is the Treasurer's Report: Halifax Community Club's profit and loss statement for June 10, reflects a net balance of \$14,131.58. In the past month we paid Suburban Propane \$225.30, Green Mountain Power \$94.56, and a local vendor \$74.75 for the plaque for the memorial picnic table, and \$21.39 for a milk shake machine. We had income of \$100 from Tai Chi and Yoga. We expect heating costs to abate and income from ice cream sales to bolster the next month's report.
- b. Treasurer's report was accepted unanimously.
- 2. **Potluck on Sunday June 4th A round of applause for Bonnie Brown!** John Kirk wrote, "Glad to see that the potluck went well. I got one letter of regret from someone on Jacksonville Stage Road who had a last-minute conflict, but otherwise would have been there and thought it was a great idea."

 - c. Wording on FPF initial announcement seemed directed to newcomers. 2nd notice on FPF did not have all the details.
 - d. There was a competing event at the same time / just before at the School. Need to find out about conflicts in advance.
 - e. Have more potlucks? Have a bonfire? Diane Todd used to have New Year's Eve bonfire up on the corner of Butterfield & Hatch School Roads.
 - f. One attendee thought it would be fun to have it monthly, but attendance is likely to fall off as it becomes routine. 2-3x/year might be good. A Winter Potluck & a Summer Potluck. How about an event with slide presentation and travel stories.
- 3. **Memorial Picnic Table** –Joan ordered and took delivery on the picnic table. 6'x6', edges rounded, center umbrella hole, spruce, pressure-treated legs, attached benches: \$385 (+\$50 delivery?). Connie Lancaster the historian of Saxons River VT donated an umbrella. Rest of funds: pad, security chain, **decorative tree**. Concrete pad with bolt & chain would secure the table.
